Eligibility: The contest is open to all ages.

Categories: 1. Family 2. Individual 3. School Group 4. Scouts 5. Non -Profit 6. Commercial 7. Miscellaneous

Rules:

This is a family friendly event. SCARECROWS can be humorous, loveable, whimsical but not frightening or distasteful. WCOM has the right to reject any and all SCARECROWS we deem to be offensive or inappropriate.

Materials must be firmly attached to the scarecrow so that it can stand up to the elements. Scarecrows are to be mounted to the assigned poles along Main Street - **assignments will be given out on OCTOBER 5, 9 AM at the gazebo. Installation will take place starting at 9 AM and all entries must be registered and in place by 11 AM.**

Scarecrows must face the shops NOT the street.

Each scarecrow must have a sign to identify the entry - Name of group, business or club and category entered. Businesses may include logo on their sign. No other advertising or political statements permitted.

All entries will be on display until the Sunday

after the Halloween Parade at which time the scarecrow MUST be removed. A deposit in the form of a check made out to WCOM for \$20 will be collected at time of registration. The check is to be in a self addressed stamped envelope and will be returned to the group/business/individual upon timely removal of the scarecrow.

Winners will be announced on DATE at 12:00 noon at the gazebo .

We recommend that you check on your scarecrow periodically to make sure it remains in presentable condition.

Entry form and \$20 check in self addressed stamped envelope will be collected at the gazebo on DATE.
